COURSE OFFERED

Bachelor of Architecture (B. Arch) - 5 year duration - 40 Seats

AFFILIATION AND APPROVAL

Approved by the Council of Architecture, New Delhi and affiliated to the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala.

ADMISSION

This prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to B. Arch. Course in the Asian School of Architecture and Design Innovations (ASADI). Admission is offered only to eligible candidates as per prevailing CoA / Government of Kerala and M.G University norms.

On the basis of agreement with the Government of Kerala, 50% of the seats are filled from the list provided by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Government of Kerala. The remaining 50% will be filled up by the management. Of this, 35% seats will be filled up by the management, and the remaining 15% of the seats will be filled up by the management from the Non Resident Indian category.

The management and NRI seats are filled up without collecting donation of any form.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility criteria as per CoA guide lines for admissions for the academic year 2022-23 is given below.

1) No candidate shall be admitted to Architecture course unless she / he has passed an examination at the end of 10+2 scheme of examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject .

2) In addition, the candidate needs to qualify in an aptitude test conducted either by NTA (JEE) or NATA conducted by the Council of Architecture, for the current admission year (2022-23).

AGE

3) Candidate should have completed 17 years age, as on 31stDecember 2022.

DURATION OF COURSE

B. Arch is a 5 year Course consisting of 10 Semesters including practical training and thesis. 1st and 2nd semesters are combined and University Examination will be held at the end of 2nd semester.

SELECTION

Selection for Govt. quota will be on the basis of allotment by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations, Kerala.

There shall be an interview and verification of documents for the allotted students at the time of admission.

Selected candidates shall submit documents required (appendix -1) and remit full fees.

Selection for Management Quota will be based on merit as per the rank list published by the institution.

Candidates thus ranked will have to appear for an interview (online/offline) before the final selection. No separate marks will be awarded for interview.

HOW TO APPLY

Aspirants for admission to management seats shall apply online. The link is available in the College website www.asadi.edu.in.

All details shall be filled in.

Furnishing false information /particulars will lead to forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

Incomplete or delayed application form will be summarily rejected.

After submission, the ASADI admission team will call the applicant for online/offline interview.

The list of selected candidates will be published in the website on the date prescribed.

At the time and date prescribed for admission, the candidate shall submit the hard copy of application documents required (Appendix 1) and remit full fees.

The hard copy of application form along with copies of necessary documents should reach the college on or before **17-08- 2022.**

The dates specified are only tentative and may change in accordance with the guidelines from CoA, MG University, Admission Supervisory Committee, and Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala and Government of Kerala.

RANK ING PROCEDURE

Rank list for admission to B. Arch Course will be prepared by giving equal weightage to the score obtained in the 'National Aptitude Test in Architecture' (NATA) and to the marks/grades obtained in the Qualifying Examination by the candidate (as per guidelines of the Council of Architecture, India).

Candidates to be considered for inclusion in the rank list for allotment to B. Arch course, have to appear for 'NATA' and secure minimum score as prescribed by COA.

Admission will be made by the college based on the applications received. The rank list will be prepared and published on the notice board of the college and college website.

Seats under Govt. quota lying vacant after the date fixed for the completion of admission will be treated as lapsed seats and will be filled up by the College from among the application received from the eligible candidates, after obtaining permission from the Govt. and Admission Supervisory Committee.

FEE STRUCTURE

The Fee structure is given below. The fee mentioned below is as per the Agreement with Government of Kerala & G.O. (M.S) No.451/2021/ HEDN dt.16.10.2021 for the Academic Year 2021-22, and will be subject to changes.

Institution fee, University fee including examination fees, ID card charges, Insurance, Internet, Locker, Extracurricular activities fees, College magazine fees ,Tour fees , Store fee etc. will also be charged seperately at the time of admission, and also annually .

Fee structure will be fixed as per the agreement executed with Govt. and Management Association (ACMA). Fee rates prescribed in the Govt. order will be applicable for the entire course period.

Proposals for revision of fees for 2022-23 admissions have been submitted to the Fee Regulatory Committee, Govt. of Kerala. The students securing admission to this college

will have to pay the new fees in case of any revision of fee in future by the Fee Regulatory Committee, Govt. of Kerala.

REMITTANCE OF FEES

Selected candidates shall take admission at the scheduled time and date appearing in person at the College. After verification of documents the tuition fee and all other fees required shall be remitted, failing which the admission will be cancelled. Payment of fees in cash is not permitted.

Students shall remit annual fees on the first working day of June every academic year. Delay in fee payment will attract fine and/ or removal from college rolls.

REFUND

Refund of fees if any will be as per clauses prescribed in the Govt. order on the basis of the agreement executed with the Govt. and Management Association (ACMA).(Clause 18 of the GO(Ms)451/2021/H.Edn dated 16.10.2021)

HOSTEL ACCOMODATION FOR STUDENTS

Separate hostels situated with adequate and modern facilities are provided, for male and female students.

COLLEGE LIBRARY
